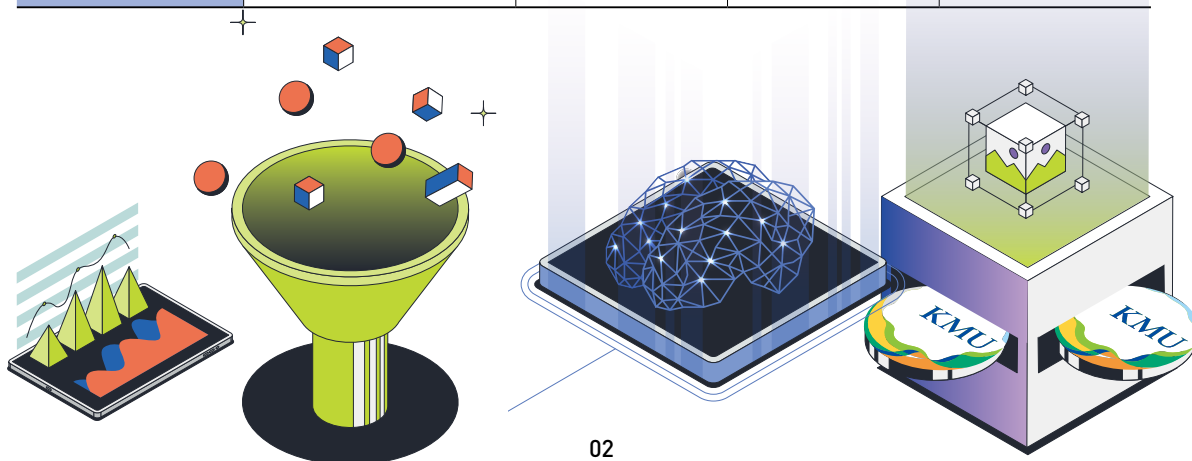

1. All documents must be written in Korean or English. Documents in other languages must be translated into Korean or English and notarized. Documents needs to be submitted with a consular legalization issued from the embassy of the respective country located in Korea.

※ Even when translated into Korean, the names of the applicant & parents and the school must be written in English.

2. All documents submitted to our institution will not be returned regardless of the admission result and additional documents other than the basic application documents may be requested when necessary.

Q1. Can Applicants apply without TOPIK score?

Yes, you may apply without TOPIK score.

However, applicants must meet one of the language requirement. (Refer to Admission Guidelines or Leaflet p.03~04)

Q2. Are there courses in English?

KMU International Business(KIBS) is entirely taught in English.

Therefore KIBS applicants must check English Language Requirement. (Refer to Admission Guidelines or Leaflet p.03~04)

Q3. What should Applicants to Colleges of Design&Arts prepare for the interview?

Applicants shall prepare and be responsible for their own preparation of Portfolio/Song/Performance.

Refer to Admission Guidelines for details.

Q4. If some documents are not ready, can I submit them later?

All documents must be submitted before the document submission deadlines.

Make sure you prepare and submit all necessary documents before the deadlines.

Q5. Can applicants get back their documents after the submission?

Submitted documents will NOT be returned to the applicants regardless of admission results.

Please be noted when submitting the documents.

Q6. When is the Certificate of Admission (Visa Documents) issued?

Successful Candidates may receive their Visa Documents after Tuition Payment.
