APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS AND PROCEDURES

Application Documents (In English):

1. Application Form (the link will be provided directly to students after nomination)
2. Student Certificate Letter or High school transcript and diploma
3. Official transcript from current university/educational institution
4. Photocopy of the passport's main page
5. Health Certificate certified by a general practitioner (obtain within 1 year)
6. Copy of health insurance covering the whole period of stay in Thailand
7. Letter of recommendation from the current university/educational institution
8. English-language proficiency test score report (obtain within 2 years):
 - TOEFL 500 PBT, 173 CBT, 3.5 IBT;
 - IELTS 5.0 in all skills;
 - TOEIC 600;
 - Duolingo English Test (DET) score 80 in all sub-score; or
 - Certification Letter from the current university/educational institution. (waived for native speakers of English)

9. Application fee of US \$70 (Not required for exchange students under the MOU). Please note that the sender is responsible for a transfer fee. A bank wire transfer must be made directly to Bangkok University's bank account:

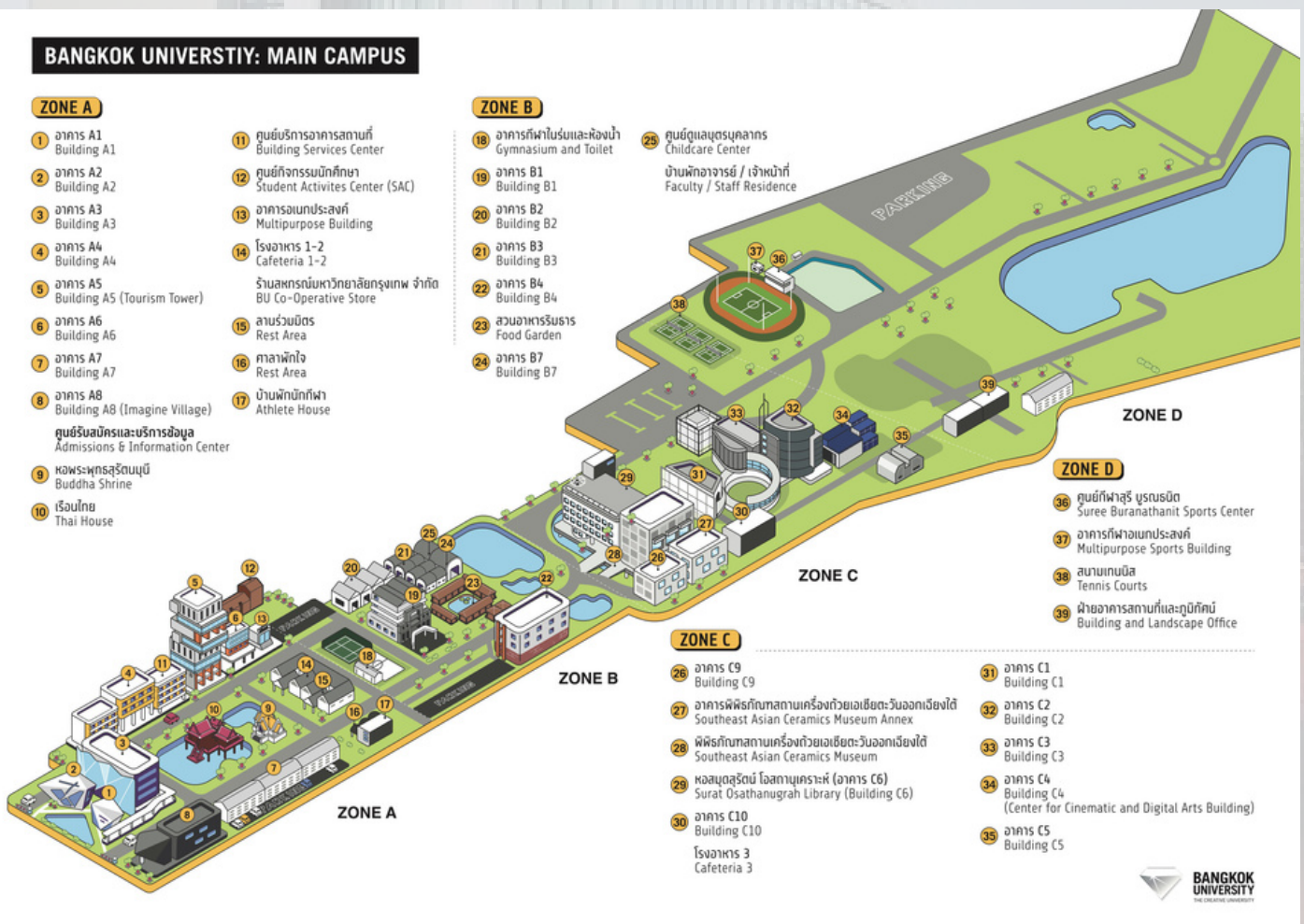

Once exchange/visiting students are accepted to our program, they shall receive a letter of acceptance and other documents required to request a Non-ED (Non-Immigrant Education Visa) visa at the Royal Thai Embassy in their countries. All students are required to complete Thailand Digital Arrival Card (TDAC) within 3 days before arrival in Thailand at <https://tdac.immigration.go.th> and report to the International Center, Building C6, Bangkok University (Main Campus) within 15 days of their arrival.

PROCESS	- Request the landlord to notify the immigration office for you, online or in person OR - Fill out the TM30 form - Submit the TM30 document at the immigration office, along with the room rental agreement, the landlord's ID card and the house registration.	- Check your latest visa stamp - Bring the following to the International Center 1 month before your visa expiration date: • Passport • Registration receipt • TM30 (if you live in Bangkok) or the room rental agreement and the landlord's ID card (if you live around the campus) - After the visa letter is issued, bring all documents to the Immigration Office - Return to us with a copy of your latest stamp	- Notify the immigration Office every 90 days of your stay in the Thai Kingdom. The notification must be made 15 days before, or 7 days after the 90-day period expires - If the student leaves the country and re-enters, the day count will re-start at 1 in every case	Obtain the permit before leaving Thailand by submitting the following documents at any immigration office or directly at the airport before departure: - A completed TM-8 form - Re-entry permit fee (1,000 THB for single entry/ 3,800 THB for multiple entries) - 1 photo (4 x 6 cm) - Photocopy of passport (main page and latest entry stamp)
IN CASE OF FAILURE	If not, you will not be eligible to extend your visa	If not, a fine of 500 Baht / day and a period of banning from re-entering will be applied	If not, you will be fined a minimum of 2,000 Baht	If not, your visa will be canceled automatically
