Language proficiency requirements

To study in Russian, the candidate must have an average level of Russian A2.

To study in English, the exchange program student also needs to have an intermediate level of language proficiency - B2.

ACADEMIC CALENDAR

OFFICIAL INVITATION AND VISA INFORMATION

The student's passport must be valid for at least 6 months after the end of the stay and contain at least 1 blank page for the visa stamp(s).

Official Invitation is issued by the Federal Migration Service of Russia.

The period for issuing a visa Invitation for visa issuance varies from 30 to 90 days.

FEFU sends a scan of the official Invitation by e-mail as soon as it is ready.

After receiving the official Invitation, the student must apply for a visa at the nearest Russian embassy or consulate in the student's country.

OFFICIAL INVITATION AND VISA INFORMATION




Students attach a scan of their passport to the Online Application on our website along with the rest of their documents.

Exchange students' passports should not expire less than 18 months before the end of the Exchange Program.





The Coordinator of inbound academic mobility checks that all the documents are correct, and then forwards the data to the Visa and Registration Office for the issuing of the Invitation.







The Coordinator will send students a scan of the Invitation by e-mail.

The student must apply for the visa at the nearest Russian embassy or consulate in the country of residence

The Visa is valid for 90 days and can be extended afterwards at the FEFU Visa & Registration Office. Visa extension - 2.100 rubles.

ACCOMODATION INFORMATION



Dormitory

FEFU guarantees to provide all participants of the Exchange Program with a room at the dormitory. No booking is necessary.

Facilities in room: bed, writing desk, chair, table lamp, wardrobe, TV-set, phone, fridge (for fee ~ 300 rub/ month), shower and toilet, internet access, bed linens provided for free of charge, cleaning service.

Security staff and administrator are at the main entrance (24/7).





Meals

- 1. Cafeteria, canteens, coffee-shops on campus (~ 750 rub a day).
- 2.Students may cook by themselves.

Kitchen, laundry on the 1st floor.

FURTHER INFORMATION





Health Insurance and Medical Service

Every FEFU student should be covered by National Russian health insurance. This can be done at the university itself, at the Office for Work with Foreigners.

The insurance company covers:

- Medical treatment in the event of an accident or sudden illness;
- Medical transportation;
- First aid in a dental emergency (up to \$150 USD);
- Cost of medication prescribed by a doctor.

Cost of health insurance 10 months ~ 4,000 rubles; 4 months ~ 2,250 rubles.



All international students who arrived in Russia are required to undergo a medical examination, state fingerprint registration, and photographing no later than 90 calendar days from the date of arrival to Russia.

This procedure is provided on a paid basis, cost is managed individually. Far Eastern Federal University arranges the organizational part of the procedures.

Tuition fee is waived for exchange students.

Payment for accommodation is accepted on the day of arrival at the dormitory.



All payments are made during the first week upon arrival.
